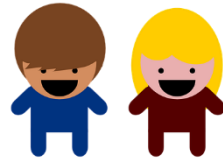

Bible verses

Philippians 4 v 12, 13: I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do all this through him who gives me strength.

1 Peter 5 v 5 – 7: All of you, clothe yourselves with humility towards one another, because, *‘God opposes the proud but shows favour to the humble.’* Humble yourselves, therefore, under God’s mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.

Look, your house is left to you desolate. I tell you, you will not see me again until you say, *“Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.”*
